 - December was literacy assessments. Done three times per year. June 2025 is the next one.
 - i. Seeing great progress.
 - **ii.** Students will be moving literacy groups when required to meet their literacy needs and goals.
 - Thank you for the funding for the art room which is beautiful. Funds used to revamp and redo the art room so please stop by to see it.
 - Anxiety session coming up on Monday, January 27, 2025

 - ii. Meeting will be virtual from 7pm to 8:15pm.
