
# Digital Citizenship, Laptop Care, and Admirable Use Policy 2023

- Ask a teacher




## Laptop Care and Printing

- Students are responsible for any damage to computers.




## End of Day Protocol

#### **Student Agreement**

Use of school owned and personal devices at Dr. Oakley School are a **privilege** and are dependent on the level of responsibility shown by individual students. It is our intent to have all students access these tools for learning on an ongoing basis.

# Permission and Supervision



 Permission and Supervision: School and personal electronic devices are only to be used with permission and under the active and direct supervision of teachers and staff members.

I understand I must ask permission every time to use a device (laptop, phone
etc.) and any supervisor has the right to say no (in school, on the school
grounds, on the bus, on field trips, etc.)

#### Personal Info



2. Personal Information: Students will not use electronic devices at school to collect, post or circulate personal information about themselves or others. Personal information could include names, phone numbers, addresses, and photographs. Students will protect their personal information at all times while using the internet.

I understand that I can't record or post ANYTHING from school (in school, on the school grounds, on the bus, on field trips, etc.). For example, taking pictures or video, or posting on Instagram or <u>Tiktok</u>.


#### Respect



Respect: Students will use appropriate language while riding the bus, at school, and
while communicating electronically with other students. Students will not use electronic
resources to harm or attempt to harm, or be hurtful to another person. Cyber-bullying
will not be tolerated.

I understand that I must use respectful language and not harm another person in anyway (in school, on school grounds, on the bus, on field trips, etc.) \_\_\_\_\_

#### Inappropriate Material



- Inappropriate Material: Students will not use electronic devices to access rude, violent, illegal, adult-oriented or otherwise inappropriate material.
  - I understand that I can't access rude or other inappropriate material (in school, on school grounds, on the bus, on field trips, etc.) \_\_\_\_\_

#### Fifters



- Filters: Students will not knowingly access websites or use online tools that allow them to evade the internet filtering technology.
  - I understand that I shouldn't try to get around the internet filters. For example, playing unblocked games \_\_\_\_\_

#### Damage



- Damage: Students will not damage or attempt to damage electronic information systems such as computers, data or networks.
  - I understand that I am responsible for any damages I cause to any tech equipment (iPads, computers, etc.). \_\_\_\_\_

### 7. Account Usage



- Account Usage: Students will only use their own designated CBE accounts and will not access any technology that another student is logged into.
  - I understand that I can't use someone else's account and that I can only use another student's assigned computer when a teacher has given me direct permission to do so. \_\_\_\_\_



# Unapproved Activity and Printing

 Unapproved Activity and Printing: Students will not intentionally use system technology on non-teacher-approved activities such as:



- Playing games or watching YouTube videos.
- Participating in non-teacher-directed chat.
- Participating in online gambling or other gaming activities.
- Downloading software or restricted files (e.g. Exe, Zip, mp3).
- Installing software or Unapproved Google Chrome extensions on any school computer or account.
- Excessive or inappropriate printing.

I understand that I should only go on sites a teacher has asked me to go on or
given me permission to go on
I will not download music or software files or install unapproved Google Chrome
extensions on school devices or my @educbe.ca account
I will only print what I'm asked or what I'm given permission to print

#### 9. Audit and Access

All electronic information resources at Dr. Oakley School are subject to monitoring and search by school staff when there are reasonable grounds to suspect misuse and abuse.
