- Wonderful Batter Boys pancake breakfast. Thank you to Jenn Lloyd and the Parent Council for organizing.
 - Beautiful weather, engaging volunteers, offered to do line dancing in the future as well.
 - Very interested in hosting again next year.
- Open house meet the teacher- over 120 families attended.
- Terry Fox run yesterday, robust collection of money.
- Orange shirt day tomorrow Orange team leading the assembly
- Drumming residency Oct. 6-10.
- 197 students attending Dr. Oakley this year. The max is 200 so there are 3 remaining spots (placement process outside of CBE) that may join the school.
 - Most classes have around 23 students.
 - Jr. high restructuring has had a positive impact. There is more of a community feel with teachers specialized in each subject and a rotation of students to different subject classes. This has replaced the model of a home room with the students in place and teachers rotating in.
- Chantal and Stephanie will be showing a brief slideshow from each class during PPA meetings in place of teachers presenting each month.
 - Blue Team presented visual journals based on senses and sit spots
 - Growth mindset a focus for this year instead of a fixed mindset (social-emotional focus, managing emotions, and creativity).

- Neurographical art created using senses. Self awareness a focus.
- Green Team
 - Novel study and art based on a Roald Dahl text.
 - Working to summarize succinctly in one sentence.
 - Field trip very successful to Sam Centre with a theme of folklore and myths.
- Orange Team
 - Working on earth systems and creating visual notes for representation of what they are learning.
 - Connecting to nature, art, and land based learning.
- Jr. High
 - explicit structure for sentences and speech, worldviews and the elements of shaping the world.
 - Canadian geography and the impact of residential schools.
 - Language comprehension utilizing a higher level thinking skills.

Treasurer's Report:

- 1. Review of current accounts, grants, and fundraising
 - Reporting requirements- Alberta Society (Oct 2024-Sept 2025) and Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (Nov 2024-Oct 31, 2025)
 - Casino funds must be used within 3 years
 - General Account- \$10,245 at present

- Casino Account- \$95,939 at present
 - Jan 2026 should aim to have spent \$39,125
 - Amount remaining until Feb 2028: \$56,815
- 2. Current school year funding requests
 - a. Drumming- already approved- total cost is \$2,855
 - b. Emergency pantry/ extra snacks- gift cards? \$300
 - c. Science/ SS funds- with the change in the Science/ SS- curriculum, we need some new learning materials (things like beakers, microscopes, art supplies for hands-on activities)- likely \$5,000-\$7,500
 - d. A whole school field trip to the Be Brave Hitmen game- we are hoping this could come out of a special fund rather than counting towards field trips \$1400 for 4 buses
 - i. The ticket cost of \$3500 is also part of this cost
 - e. Field trips allocations of \$1750 per elementary team and \$4500 for junior high? **Total of \$15,000.** This is a slight increase- \$13000 would be equivalent to last year with increase in students.
 - f. IXL online learning platform for math which helps assess and support students at the level they are working at. Cost is **\$2,400**
 - g. Weekly World News- online current events resource- approx **\$450** will get the exact amount for the meeting
 - h. Technology- TBD up to \$10,000
 - i. Would occur at the end of this year to benefit next year
 - ii. Typically, replacement of Chromebooks for students, a few additional carts that need to be replaced
